Reference: BWM Convention 2004, Resolution MEPC.174 (58)

Purpose: Guideline for Shipowners/Managers and Recognized Organization concerning Acceptance of BWM systems which are approved by other contracting governments

On 12th January, 2015 Georgia acceded International Convention for the Control and Management of Ships' Ballast Water and Sediments (the Ballast Water Management Convention). Regulation D-3 of the Annex to the Ballast Water Management Convention requires that ballast water management systems used to comply with this Convention must be approved by the Administration, taking into account Guidelines developed by the
