SUBJECT: Civil Liability Certificates (CLC) for Oil Pollution Damage

Maritime Transport Agency of the Ministry of Economy of Sustainable Development of Georgia (MTA) hereby informs you that according to International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage 1969, Protocol of 1992- (The Civil Liability Convention) Article VII - requires the registered owners of ships to maintain insurance or other financial security to cover their liability for oil pollution damage. The Convention applies to all seagoing vessels actually carrying oil in bulk as cargo, but only ships carrying more than 2,000 tons of oil are required to maintain insurance in respect of oil pollution damage.

Civil Liability Certificate will be issued by the MTA on the basis of insurance document - “Blue Card” issued by P&I insurer. Details of P&I insurer shall be duly provided to MTA for the purpose of review and approval on the following address:
